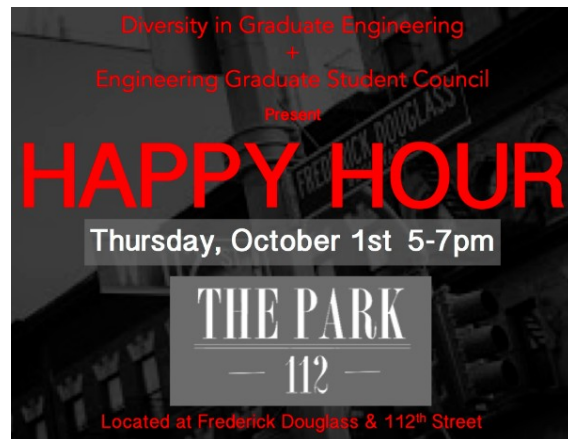


## General Body Meeting
